TRADITION VALLÉE D'AOSTE PINOT NOIR

VARIETAL: Pinot Noir 100%

PARCELS: 2, in the towns of Saint Pierre and Villeneuve

PLANTING YEAR: 1989 - 1998

ALTITUDE: 800 m asl

SOIL: Sandy moraine

DENSITY: 10,000 vines / ha

VINE TRAINING: Spurred cordon

YIELD PER HECTARE: 6 t

VINIFICATION: Red vinification with 20% of whole grapes

AGING: For 10 months in barrique (pièces)

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13,5%

TASTING NOTES:

Ruby with shades of garnet. Varietal aromas ranging from earth to herbs, from leather to cherry. The palate, juicy and tonic, is punctuated by mentholated hints, notes of wild berries and a complete development, with a compact tannin and a finish marked by notes of pepper.
